



Public comment time will be allotted during each council meeting at the beginning of the meeting regarding items on the agenda before any items are discussed on which action may be taken so comments may be heard by the governing body. No more than 10 minutes will be allotted for this section of the agenda. No action may be taken regarding any topic during this public comment section and the council members are not allowed to respond, but rather must wait until the topic at hand is included as an action item on a future agenda. A time limit of three (3) minutes per comment will be imposed on public comments to allow all members of the public the opportunity to speak. These comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.

Public comment can also be submitted prior to a meeting via Google Form linked on Horizon Academy West's Website and will be included in the minutes and provided to the Council.

All requests for public comment must be made 72 hours before the regular meeting date.

The GC reserves the right to limit or curtail repetitive comments or other expressions that are obscene, profane, disruptive of the orderly conduct of the GC's meeting, harassing or defamatory or not in keeping with the decorum of a school board meeting which includes students or other minors.

Complaints regarding personnel matters or involving students may be redirected to appropriate administrative procedures for review and handling.
